

Legal Notice

Registration

Each participant has to be at least 18 years old or needs to be represented by their legal guardian/parents; this also applies for the registration process.

Registration & payment occurs at www.IAAPH.org/certify via PayPal (www.paypal.com); IAAPH accepts payments via credit card or bank transfer.

The IAAPH only accepts the registration once the candidate has submitted a COMPLETED application and payment has been received by the IAAPH in FULL. The registration will be confirmed once the candidate receives a confirmation email from IAAPH.

Fees are subject to change without notice

Cancellation & Refund

All cancellations must be in writing and received by IAAPH to be considered; the day the communication was received by the IAAPH is essential to determine any refund if applicable.

The candidate may cancel the registration at any time. If the cancellation occurs 4 weeks (28 days) or earlier then IAAPH refunds 100% of the course fee. Otherwise the refund policy is as follows:

- 21 - 27 days prior to the event = 75% refund
- 15 - 26 days prior to the event = 65% refund
- 14 days or less = no refund

No refund shall be given if the candidate doesn't show up to the event

If the participant cannot attend the event due to illness then a doctor's note (attest) must be supplied in a timely fashion and the participant can reschedule.

Event Cancellation

Due to special circumstances or events of higher power, cancellations can occur on short notice. This includes, but is not limited to, illness of course instructors, minimum of course participants isn't reached, event location cannot be utilized or other unforeseen circumstances.

In the event of a cancellation IAAPH will schedule an alternate course date as soon as possible. If a participant cannot attend the alternate course date then IAAPH will promptly issue a refund.

Apart from the refund, the participant waives the rights to all further claims unless IAAPH acts intentionally or in neglect.

IAAPH can substitute course instructors or make changes to the program on short notice.

Pictures & Videos

The production of pictures and video footage pre-, during- and post the event may occur

All the copyrights and/or other legal claims to the images, pictures and videos belong exclusively to IAAPH.

If the participant doesn't want to be photographed or included in the video footage then IAAPH must be notified in writing prior to the event.

Liability

IAAPH isn't liable for any injuries or damages sustained during the event.

All participants must be in good physical health. If in doubt, it is recommended to get clearance from your doctor.

IAAPH isn't responsible for any damages participants inflict on others.

IAAPH isn't liable for any damages sustained due to wrongful execution of the exercises or misuse of the exercises by the participant during and after the event.

Miscellaneous

IAAPH may distribute equipment and/or materials during the event to the event participants, which must be returned to IAAPH in good working condition before the event is over.

The event participant will carefully follow instructions by IAAPH staff (e.g. course instructor).

The event participant ensures to wear proper sports clothing and shoes (clean sneakers) and maintain personal hygiene standard. (e.g. use of deodorant and towel).

The participant has to respect the event staff and abide by the house rules.
